THE PROJECT

The new crossing under the River Thames will almost double road capacity between Kent and Essex, ease congestion across the region, and divert over 13 million vehicles away from the Dartford Crossing each year, currently the only river crossing east of London. The ambitious scheme includes the longest road tunnels in the UK, 14.3 miles of new road, new viaducts, seven new green bridges, and 24 miles of new paths connecting habitants and communities. The Lower Thames Crossing will add billions to the local economy and play an important part in the Government's plan to level up the UK.

H&M Security Services have been working with Balfour Beatty at Lower Thames Crossing since 2020 providing the site security, mobile patrol team and traffic management personnel on the compounds. THE CHALLENGE

Given that the project requires numerous compounds in the North (Essex) and South (Kent) of the Thames, the daily operational management of all compounds on the project is an important factor. Considering any issues that may occur on the compounds can have a knock-on effect on the delivery of services which can provide a negative effect for the final project delivery.

In addition to the compounds, the large footprint between North and South of the Thames include multiple access points used by the many subcontractors working on the project. A flexible security solution is required to deliver against all objectives for safety, quality, and delivery of the project.

THE SOLUTION

H&M Security are able to deploy fully licensed security officers to cover all the compounds on a 24-hour basis. Mobile cameras monitored through 24/7 control room are supported by mobile teams providing a cost effective and flexible response.
